

CBIP Certification and the PECPR regulations

1. CBIP is authorised by the New Zealand Department of Labour to act as a Qualification Issuing Agency.
2. CBIP's policies and procedures are intended to ensure that CBIP complies with Regulation 29 (3) of the "Health and Safety in Employment (Pressure Equipment, Cranes and Passenger Ropeways) Regulations 1999, which states –

"A qualification issuing agency must ensure that it issues a certificate of competency only after a determination (by way of examination, assessment, or otherwise) that the person concerned has the knowledge, training; skills and experience to perform competently every activity that the holder of the certificate of competency would be expected to perform competently."
